It describes the forces behind climate change and the damaging impacts rising temperatures and industrial emissions wreak on the ocean. It discusses the issue of marine litter, especially the extraordinarily challenging problem of plastic wastes. It covers ballast water and the worldwide spread of aquatic nuisance species. It treats liquid pollutants like oil and why they must be carefully

controlled, and the challenge posed by toxic pollutants like TBT. It offers the modern seaman a call to action for helping protect the realm where he or she lives and works.

Photographed on location aboard working ships in Europe, Trinidad, California, Oregon and Washington State, the *Ship Safety Suite* offers vessel operators, trade organizations, vocational schools and marine safety agencies a wide ranging set of vessel familiarization and health, safety, security and environmental training
