Photographed on location aboard working ships in Europe, Trinidad, California, Oregon and Washington State, the *Ship Safety Suite* offers vessel operators, trade organizations, vocational schools and marine safety agencies a wide ranging set of vessel familiarization and health, safety, security and environmental training guidelines. Available on individual DVDs or as a four-title set, the recommendations are drawn from the International Safety Management (ISM) Code. The program is a companion to the Onboard Basic Safety Training Program, which covers the training requirements of the international Standards of Training, Certification or STCW Code.

The first program in the series, *Ship Safety Orientation*, begins with a discussion of the goal of modern vessel

It discusses the importance of ship familiarization training for new hands, and goes on to cover maritime security, the HSSE (health, safety, security and environmental) management system, safety and survival at sea, safety on the job, basic seamanship, accident and injury reporting, onboard emergencies and zero tolerance for controlled

substances. The program offers an introduction to shipboard environmental management.

The second title, *The Program of Shipboard Safety* offers a formal approach to accident and injury prevention that applies to all crew personnel as well as to vendors and sub-

It stresses the importance of overlapping layers of responsibility for accident and injury prevention and outlines defined responsibilities for personnel involved in each work task. The program proposes guidelines for managing routine and hazardous tasks, near miss reporting, job hazard analysis, permits to work and auditing.
